






Our Catholic Tradition

- The Church is made up of the baptized people who believe in God and follow Jesus. (ccc, 751-752)
- We say "yes" to Jesus and as his Church share his message of God's Kingdom. (ccc. 763)
- God the Holy Spirit is at work with God the Father and God the Son in the whole world. (ccc. 686)
- The Holy Spirit guides people in the Church to live holy lives like the Saints. (ccc. 736)


God's Word

Noah Says "Yes"

Noah was a good man. God told Noah to build an ark, or very large boat.

God said it was going to rain for forty days and forty nights. There would be a flood. God wanted Noah to be safe.





God told Noah to take his family and two of each kind of animal into the ark. Noah said, "Yes!" and did as God said.

Then the rains came. The rivers swelled until they flooded all the Earth. Noah, his family, and all the animals stayed dry in the ark.

After forty days, the rain stopped.
God promised that water would never flood the whole Earth again.

God gave Noah and his family a sign of his promise. God put a rainbow in the sky.

Underline what the rich man said when no one showed up for the party.




The Parable of the Great Feast





People of Faith


Blessed Mary Theresa of Jesus Gerhardinger, 1797–1879

Caroline Gerhardinger was born in Germany. She was a teacher, but she believed Jesus was asking her to be a religious sister. She always said "yes" to Jesus, so she started the School Sisters of Notre Dame. Caroline's new name was Mary Theresa of Jesus. She opened schools in Germany and the United States. She was happy to do what Jesus asked.

All: Amen.





CHILDREN AT THIS AGE >>>

How They Understand Saying "Yes" to God God speaks to us in many ways. We simply need to learn to listen to his voice. Before first-graders can understand what it means to say "yes" to God, they must understand how to recognize the call of God. They can do this when adults in their lives help them to hear God's Word in Scripture. Children also experience God's call in their talents, dreams, and opportunities in their daily lives. As time goes on, your child will become better and better at answering the question, "What might God be saying to me right now?"



CONSIDER THIS >>>


When did you realize that your perspective was limited by your personal experience?
