God the Holy Spirit

How does the Holy Spirit guide us?

We need guides to help lead us and teach us. A ranger guides people who visit a park. A tour guide helps people to find important places in a city that they are visiting. A guide in the children's museum can help children to learn about the interesting things that are there.

You need a guide to stay close to God the Father and to Jesus, who is also God the Son. God the **Holy Spirit** will help guide you.

The guide who came to them is the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is with us today. He lives in the whole Church.

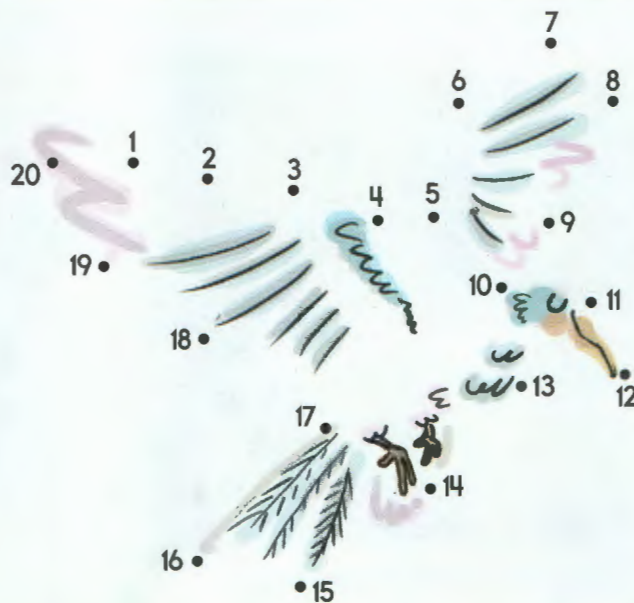

Saint Thérèse of Lisieux

Thérèse was the youngest child in her family. She knew that God loved her. She loved God very much, too.

She felt that God had not called her to do some of the great big, brave things that some of the Saints had done. But she knew she could still work for God through her little jobs. This is called “the little way.” She knew that God would see the love in her work.

After Thérèse grew up, she wrote about her little way in a book. Many people read the book and followed the little way. Thérèse helped many people find God. She is a special Saint.

Gifts of the Holy Spirit

Gift

How It Helps

wisdom

helps you see yourself and others as God sees you

understanding

helps you get along with others

right judgment (counsel)

helps you make good choices

courage (fortitude)

helps you act bravely

knowledge

helps you know God better

reverence (piety)

helps you pray every day

wonder and awe (fear of the Lord)

helps you understand how great and powerful God is

Saint Rose of Lima, 1586–1617

Saint Rose of Lima was named Isabel at birth. Her family said she was as pretty as a flower, so they called her “Rose.” The Holy Spirit gave Rose the gift of piety. She prayed and fasted every day. She loved God’s wonderful world. She used her gift to grow beautiful flowers that she sold to help support her family and care for the poor.

CHILDREN AT THIS AGE >>>

How They Understand the Holy Spirit Even in the most general terms, “God” and “Trinity” are abstract concepts for first-grade children, but the Holy Spirit tends to be the most elusive of all. It's difficult for children this age to grasp this Person of the Trinity who also dwells within the hearts of all Christians. You can help make this more concrete by referring to Gifts and Fruits of the Holy Spirit. It will also help if your child understands that the Holy Spirit helps us to make good choices and prompts us to be loving toward others.



CONSIDER THIS >>>

Do you remember a time when you really needed a guide?

Maybe the journey was long, or the best of directions were still not clear. A good guide can lessen frustration, get you where you need to be, or in some cases give you information you didn't know. The Holy Spirit guides the Church. Whenever you need direction, or you seek to know God's will in your life, remember—“We do not work alone. The Holy Spirit is our teacher and guide” (*USCCA, p.16*).

- Ask your child to share a time when he or she was guided or helped.
- Share about a time when the Holy Spirit guided you or helped you pray.
