

Who is the Holy Trinity?

You cannot see the wind, but you know that it is there. You cannot see God the **Holy Spirit** either, but you can see what the Spirit does.



God's Word

The Promise

Jesus knew he would be returning to his Father in Heaven. He wanted his followers to continue his work.

Jesus promised his followers, "The Advocate, the holy Spirit that the Father will send in my name—he will teach you everything and remind you of all that [I] told you." **Based on John 14:15–26**

Father, Son, and Holy Spirit

Jesus teaches you that God is the Father of all. Jesus is the Son of God. And the Holy Spirit, sent from the Father and the Son, is also God.

But there are not three gods. There is only one God, who is Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The Church's name for the one God in three Divine Persons is the **Holy Trinity**.

God the Father is the First Person of the Holy Trinity. God the Son became man in Jesus Christ. He is the Second Person of the Holy Trinity. God the Holy Spirit is the Third Person of the Holy Trinity.

Believing in the Holy Trinity is the most important part of your faith and you show your belief when you make the Sign of the Cross.



Guided by the Spirit

How is the Holy Spirit with us today?

Jesus' followers are called his **disciples**. Before he returned to Heaven, he told them his plan.

God's Word

The Spirit Comes


Jesus told his disciples to wait for the promise of the Father that he had told them about. He said, "You will receive power when the holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem . . . and to the ends of the earth."

The Twelve disciples and some other followers of Jesus stayed in Jerusalem and prayed. Soon the Holy Spirit came. Suddenly a noise like a strong driving wind came from the sky, and it filled the entire house in which they were gathered. Then tongues of fire appeared to them, which parted and came to rest on each one of them. This day is called Pentecost.

The Holy Spirit Today

After the Holy Spirit came to them at **Pentecost**, Jesus' Twelve closest disciples were guided to continue his work. They became known as his **Apostles**.

The Holy Spirit comes today through the Church's Sacraments, prayer, and in God's Word. The Holy Spirit guides the Church and makes Jesus' disciples holy. He helps you make good decisions and grow more loving.

Disciples of Jesus

Jesus' disciples are in every part of the world. The Holy Spirit teaches us all how to pray. The Spirit helps today's disciples remember and understand the stories of Jesus. You are learning to be a disciple of Jesus.



What does it mean to follow Jesus?

Jesus' first followers were his friends. They traveled with Jesus and listened to his stories. They saw how Jesus treated others. Jesus asked his Apostles and other disciples to help others learn about God's love.

You are Jesus' friend and follower, too. He wants you to listen to him and to live the way he lived. Being a disciple of Jesus means following his example.

Ways to Follow Jesus

- Pray to God the Father.
- Ask God the Holy Spirit to guide you.
- Think of other people, not only of yourself.
- Be fair to your family members and friends.
- Help people who are in need.

People of Faith

Saint Arnold Janssen, 1837–1909

Saint Arnold Janssen was a German priest. He wanted everybody to know about Jesus. He helped priests and sisters, serving as missionaries, build churches all around the world. They went to faraway places like China. Saint Arnold prayed to the Holy Spirit to help with his work. He asked some religious sisters to help him pray. These sisters took turns praying all day and night for the missionaries. Today, sisters like these are sometimes called “Pink Sisters” because they wear pink habits.

CHILDREN AT THIS AGE >>>

How They Understand God the Holy Spirit The Holy Spirit might still be difficult for your child to understand, but children this age are growing in their understanding that the Holy Spirit lives in their heart. Because cause and effect is so important to children this age, reflecting on the Gifts and Fruits of the Spirit can help second-graders see the work of the Holy Spirit in their own lives. Talk with your child about the Fruits and Gifts of the Spirit (See the We Live section in the back of your book.), and point out times when you see examples in their actions.



CONSIDER THIS >>>

Imagine being invited somewhere you really want to go.

The greatest invitation we ever get is the invitation to spend all of eternity with God. "Heaven is the ultimate end and fulfillment of the deepest human longings, the state of supreme, definitive happiness' (CCC, no. 1024). This will be brought about by a perfect communion with the Holy Trinity, the Blessed Mother, the angels and saints. Jesus Christ opened heaven to us by his death and Resurrection" (USCCA, p. 153).
