

During the Church year the **liturgy**, or public prayer, celebrates the events in the life of Jesus. In her **worship**, the Church praises God and celebrates the light of Jesus throughout the Church year.

Advent

During the four weeks of Advent, the Church gets ready to celebrate Jesus' birth. You tell God that you want to get better at loving him and others. Just as the seasons of the year have different colors, so do the Church's seasons. The color for Advent is violet. It is a sign of getting ready and change of heart.

Christmas

The three weeks of the Christmas season celebrate Jesus' presence in the world. The Son of God came so all people could know his Father's love. The Christmas celebrations help people love Jesus and other people more. White or gold are the colors for the Christmas season. They are a sign of great joy.

Ordinary Time

Ordinary Time comes twice during the Church year. The first time comes after the Christmas season. The second is after the Easter season. During these times, you learn more about Jesus and grow as his follower. Green is the season's color because it is the color of growth.



The lily is a sign of joy, hope, and life. It reminds us of how we grow in Christ.

Celebrating Jesus

What is the greatest feast of the year?

Lent

The Season of Lent is a preparation for the important feast of Easter. For forty days and six Sundays, the Church's color is violet. As during Advent, you are asked to make changes that will help you grow closer to Jesus. It's a special time to show God you are sorry and fully focused on him. You are to pray more often and help others.

The Three Days

The three days before Easter are the holiest days of the Church year. On Holy Thursday, the Church celebrates Jesus' gift of the Eucharist at the Last Supper. It is a happy occasion, a time of joy, so the color is white.

On Good Friday, the Church gives thanks to Jesus as Savior. The color is red because Jesus died for all people. Holy Saturday evening begins the Easter celebration. For this joyous feast, the color is white.

Easter

Every Sunday, the Church celebrates the **Resurrection**, when Jesus was raised from the dead. But each year, the Church also celebrates the Resurrection of Jesus for fifty days from Easter to Pentecost. Easter is the greatest feast of the Church year. The color during this season is white.

The last ten days of this season celebrate Jesus' promise to send the Holy Spirit. Pentecost is the celebration of the Holy Spirit coming to the Apostles, Mary, and other disciples. For this feast, the color red is used as a sign of the power of the Holy Spirit.





Pope Saint Victor, d. 199

Pope Saint Victor was the first Pope from Africa. When he was Pope, people couldn't agree when to celebrate Easter. They needed to know the day of Easter to plan the seasons of the Church year. Pope Victor and the bishops decided that it must be celebrated on Sunday. He also knew it was important for people to be able to understand the Mass, which was only said in Latin. He declared that the Mass should be said in the language of the people, and today the Mass is said in many languages, including Latin.

CHILDREN AT THIS AGE >>>

How They Understand the Church Year Children at this age have grown in their awareness of special seasons and times of year. They understand at what time of year they will have a birthday or celebrate Christmas or Easter. They might have missed some of the more subtle indicators of changes in the Church year, like changes in color of vestments and church decor, but can begin to identify them with some help. Point out to your child the times when something has changed in the church to mark a change in the Church year. See if your child can tell you what is different.



CONSIDER THIS >>>

Do you have family traditions in your home that celebrate the Church seasons?

All traditions give children and adults alike a deep sense of continuity and rootedness. Traditions that communicate God's presence in our lives draw us ever closer to God and our Church. "In the Liturgical Year, the Church celebrates the whole mystery of Christ from the Incarnation until the day of Pentecost and the expectation of Christ's second coming... The presence of the Risen Lord and his saving work permeates the entire Liturgical Year: Advent, the Christmas season, Lent, the Easter season, and Ordinary Time" (*USCCA p. 173*).
