
Saint Teresa of Calcutta, 1910–1997

Saint Teresa of Calcutta was born in Albania. She was named Agnes by her parents. When she grew up, she became a nun. Her new name was Mother Teresa. She worked in Calcutta, India, far from her home. She cared for the poor and dying. She began a new group of sisters called the Missionaries of Charity. When people asked, "What can we do to help the people who are poor?" Mother Teresa told them to use their gifts of time, talent, and treasure to build God's Kingdom. She said, "Do something beautiful for God."

CHILDREN AT THIS AGE >>>

How They Understand Sharing the Good News Children in second grade may think of sharing the Good News of Jesus only as talking about God. While telling others about our faith is an important part of sharing the Gospel, the witness of our lives is the most powerful testimony we can give to our belief in Christ. Second-graders can begin to understand this through the guidance of parents and other teachers as they point out the many choices we make each day, often witnessed by other people. Even when we cannot preach with our words, our actions can say a lot about who we are and what we believe.



CONSIDER THIS >>>


Do you believe that your actions speak louder than your words?

Research tells us that people trust body language more than verbal language. Jesus offered us the perfect image of God, as his words and actions never contradict each other. "We are called, in imitation of the Lord Jesus, to be people who offer ourselves willingly in service to others. Actions of such service can point to Christ's Kingdom of love, justice, mercy, and salvation to all persons, cultures, governments, and other structures of society. We are also called to a life of service to the Church herself" (USCCA, p. 118).
