## Listen to God's Word



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
Leader: Lord, your Word gives us hope.

## @ God's Word

Jesus learned the stories of the Jewish people. He studied Scripture and talked about God's law with


wise teachers. Jesus was a wonderful teacher, too.

He told many parables. Parables are stories about everyday life that Jesus told to help his followers learn how to love and follow God. Jesus wanted everyone to know that the Kingdom would grow with prayer and sharing in God's work of love, peace, and justice. Here is one parable Jesus told.

## The Scripture Readings Begin

The first main part of the Mass is the **Liturgy** of the Word. The assembly listens to God's Word from the Bible.


- The reader steps forward to proclaim the first reading. It is usually from the Old Testament.
- Next, a singer, called a cantor, leads everyone in singing a psalm. Remember, psalms are prayers found in the Old Testament.
- Then, either another reader or the same reader stands and reads the second reading from one of the letters in the New Testament.
- At the end of each reading, the reader says,
   "The word of the Lord." The assembly answers,
   "Thanks be to God."

After each reading, everyone quietly thinks about what they have heard.

## Jesus' Good News

# What happens after the First and Second Readings?

Now, everyone stands and sings "Alleluia!" It is time to hear the Good News of Jesus Christ.

"The Lord be with you," says the priest or deacon. The assembly immediately replies, "And with your spirit."

The priest or deacon announces what Gospel is going to be read. The Gospels contain stories about Jesus, the words of Jesus, and stories that Jesus told. The priest or deacon reads the Good News of Jesus from one of the Gospels.

At the end of the Gospel, the priest or deacon says, "The Gospel of the Lord." Everyone says, "Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ."

After the Gospel reading, the priest or deacon gives a **homily**, a short talk about the readings that helps explain what it means to follow Jesus.

Prayer of the Faithful prayer at Mass for the needs of the Church and the world

The assembly then stands to pray the **creed**. We say proudly that we believe in God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. We say that we believe in the Church and her teachings.

Next, the assembly stands together and prays the **Prayer of the Faithful**.

As a leader says each prayer, we respond with our answer, such as "Lord, hear our prayer."

- We pray for the leaders of the Church and of our country.
- We pray for those who are sick and those who have died.
- We pray for people all around the world who have needs at this time.


### Saint Paul, first century

Saint Paul did not always like Christians. He helped put them in jail. Then one day, Paul heard a voice from above say, "Why do you persecute me?" It was Jesus. Paul realized that he had done wrong. That very minute, Paul stopped hurting Christians. Instead, he went everywhere telling people about Jesus. He started many churches. He traveled and wrote letters to teach about God. He gave people advice on how to love Jesus. Now we read his letters at Mass. They are called "Epistles."

#### CHILDREN AT THIS AGE >>>

How They Understand the Liturgy of the Word Secondgraders might not have yet picked up the connection between the Lectionary readings in Mass. Paying attention to the relationship between each Sunday's passages from the Old Testament, Psalms, New Testament, and Gospel will help your child's overall understanding of the Scriptures and will encourage more active participation in the Mass. #### **CONSIDER THIS >>>**

Do you long to hear God's voice?

Longing for God's presence is part of our human experience. Our desire for God is written in our hearts, because man is created by God and for God. "Every human person seeks to know the truth and to experience goodness. Moral goodness appeals to us.... The more we become aware of these truths, the more we are drawn to the reality of God who is the Supreme Good. These are the seeds of eternity within us that have their origins only in God" (USCCA, p. 4).

#### LET'S TALK >>>

- Ask your child to describe what happens in the Liturgy of the Word, the first main part of the Mass (readings, homily, creed, Prayer of the Faithful).
- Talk about times you have read the Bible as a family or when you were a child or adult.
