At our Baptism, we became members of the Catholic Church.




The Church is a family of people who believe in Jesus.

The Lesson Your Child Learned

Catholics first receive spiritual life at Baptism. This life is strengthened with Confirmation and nourished through the Eucharist. Throughout our lives, we grow in our understanding of what it really means to be incorporated into Jesus' passion, death, and Resurrection. It is through their parents' faith that children first learn what it is to be Catholic, witnessing to Jesus as members of his Church in the world today. In this chapter, the children heard again that they were made members of the Church through Baptism. They learned about the role of the priest and the other members of the parish community.





Living the Lesson.

No matter what time of the day or night, somewhere around the world, people are gathering in Catholic churches to celebrate the Eucharist. Every day, in places all over the world, people are joining together as Christians to feed the hungry, heal the sick, tend to the brokenhearted, and preach the Good News.
